Open to exploration and enquiry:

Leadership for all life

Yet to enact this change, leaders must first be willing to challenge the current paradigms and standard ways of perceiving, knowing, and acting in the world and, thereby, be open to the transformative nature of personal development and the inner work of leadership.

Working with mutual purpose

An all-life orientation to the leadership needs of the planet requires a collaborative approach based on mutual purpose, supported by a Consortium of organizations, who work in partnership to co-develop strategic leaders.

This is both a process and a model of interdependency and self-governance, that guides leadership development for all Consortium members and the stakeholders they engage with.

The benefits of a Consortium include:

- Engagement of member company representatives and principals in jointly defining the learning community, themes, and objectives of the Consortium's initiatives.
- Enhancement of participants' personal and organizational learning, through open sharing of perspectives, practices, and experiences among peers from member organizations.
- Personal development within an organizational context, by combining the individual and organizational worldview in a learning experience.
- Community building within and across organizations and the development of a cadre of leaders with a shared objective of building organizations of positive consequence.



The conscious leadership program

The CLP is comprised of learning experiences in different geographic, cultural, societal, ecological, and business contexts.

Embedded within these various contexts are multiple forms of engagement designed to:

- Build and deepen awareness of self, others, and the world; perceive interdependencies and think systemically; maintain presence and openness through integrating multiple ways of perceiving; and to bridge differing orientations.
- Challenge fundamental assumptions at the individual, organizational, and societal level; recognize emergent and disruptive forces that provide opportunity for innovation; and address key questions as they relate to the purpose and practice of business, future visions of social and ecological wellbeing, and economic models of growth and consumption consistent with these aspirations.
- Develop capability to address the challenges of the modern era with innovative and sustainable solutions that recognize the intrinsic value of all life and the relational and holistic quality of wellbeing.
- Cultivate the capacity for building models, strategies, and cultures within their teams, organization, industries, and society, that generate a healthy world for future generations.

The design includes:

- Series-based participation that covers a period of approximately 6 months in overall length.
- Both on-site and virtual components.
- Multiple modes of engagement to include workshops, small group action learning projects, leadership coaching, seminars, and learning expeditions.
- Residential components held in contextual, rich environments that offer an opportunity for Nature immersion and learning from place.

Residential hubs, in Northern Europe and the Western Cape of South Africa, provide both meaningful immersion opportunities and support an ecologically sound design.
